On Tuesday, May 9, 2017, at approximately 5:15 p.m., the City Council will conduct a public hearing on the surplus and transfer of 1.95 acres, located near Puyallup Avenue, from the Public Utilities Department to the Public Works Department, for the replacement of the Puyallup Avenue Bridge, for the amount of \$50,000.
